Important points of the tour

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS CLARIFICATION

1. Parents/Guardians with Junior representatives (13s & 16s only) - acquiring off site accommodation

- Being an Official Tag20 Australian Tour, players are part of an Official Australian Team.
- The logistics of players selected from different regions of Australia, the team environment, time spent together and comradery are paramount in the gelling of the teams.

Therefore, we encourage the players to spend as much time together as possible whilst off the field.

2. Adjusted BASE package costs for those with off site accommodation (13s & 16s only)

- BASE package \$690 - \$350 = **\$340**
The accommodation is only one component of the Base package, its value in the package is \$350, in which will be deducted from the official Base Package cost of \$690.
- There are many components that make up the remaining \$340 of the Tour package.
- \$380 rego & tour gear + \$340 = **\$720** New Full Tour Package Cost

3. New \$720 cost & payment schedule for Junior representatives (13s & 16s only) staying off site

- \$300 15 July 2017 (non refundable Deposit)
- \$300 3 Sept 2017 (non refundable Deposit)
- \$120 21 Oct 2017 Final Payment

4. Senior representatives with young families – acquiring off site accommodation

- Tag20 Australia allows Senior representatives to stay with their families at off site accommodation. However, they MUST still commit to the \$1070 Full Tour Package Cost.
- This ensuring all component benefits of the Full Tour Package remain secured for the entire tour group.



- Unfortunately the tour has been prearranged in advance to secure a tour package, directly for players selected to play for Australia, and the cost of the tour package having already been finalized. Any family options are at the discretion of the players,
- For future tours, we will access options for family orientated accommodation, to better accommodate those in need of special requirements.
- Tag20 fully understands that this may not suit all players, but this tour has been designed for players to represent Australia in the sport of Tag20 in NZ, we have tried to work within the parameters that have been set for the majority of the players touring, but there is always players that fall out of those parameters to whom we apologise, but this has been organised and costed as a group tour.

5. Team transfers between trainings & the tournament

- TRAINING DAYS – Wednesday / Thursday
8:00am – 4:00pm If all players can be at the official accommodation venue ready to board the bus with their respective team.
- TOURNAMENT DAYS – Friday / Saturday / Sunday
7:00am – 6:00pm If all players can be at the official accommodation venue ready to board the bus with their respective team.

To be fair to ALL players in the team and the entire tour party in general, The Australian team that the players has been selected for requires the player to travel as part of the Tour to and from Trainings and Tournament.

Tag20 will not be held responsible for players punctuality or if a player misses their bus. Due to the bus scheduling, they will not be able to prolong their departure. We kindly ask parents/guardians and senior players to please help us by being on time.

- As an Official Tag20 Australia organised & sanctioned tour, players, parents/guardians are asked to the best of their ability to meet all criteria's set out for this tour, making it as smooth as possible.
- We do not want teams to be inhibited in any such way that makes it difficult for the coaches or the teams themselves from performing at their peak due to missing or late attendees.

Please Note:

The Buses, Travel Insurance and other Tour Package inclusions, including lunch at trainings and shelter at the tournament are for players, paid supporters and officials only.

Parents and supporters staying off site will need to make their own arrangements in regards to these.
